

NOTICE TO RETURNED VETERANS

Have you brought or shipped a souvenir machine gun, machine pistol, or "sawed off" rifle to this country? If so, you should take steps to register this weapon with the Commissioner of Internal Revenue, Washington, D. C. at once. Failure to do so will expose you to severe penalties for violation of law. (Five years imprisonment and \$2,000 fine.) You will not be deprived of any souvenir lawfully in your possession. The following type guns need not be registered with the Federal Government.

Revolvers.

Semi-automatic pistols such as the P-38 Walther and Jap model 14 Nambu.

The following type guns must be registered:

Any machine gun, machine pistol or any type of weapon from which more than one shot may be fired by means of one continuous pull of the trigger.

Any pistol with a shoulder stock attached.

Any gun designed to be fired from the shoulder and having a barrel of less than 18" in length.

If you have shipped a weapon of the type requiring registration to your home in a state other than Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana or Alaska, ask your Counsellor to consult his list of registration offices for that state.
